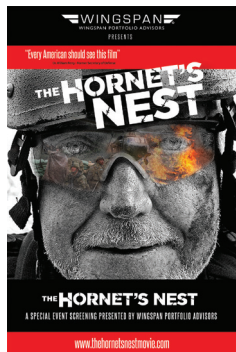
## We Salute JPMC for Supporting Our Heroes
